## COMPLIANCE

Several complaints have resulted in organized enforcement of HOA Rules. Austin Farey has agreed to act as Chair Person and leader of the ACC. This group will canvas the neighborhood at least once / month, to make sure properties are in compliance. A first offense will result in a warning letter. If the condition is not corrected a fine will be imposed and

warning letter mailed. Following further notices legal action and/or fines/liens may take place.

Vehicles in violation of Mon-Fri parking rules will be issued a warning ticket for the  $1^{st}$  violation. Following the  $1^{st}$  warning, vehicles will be "booted", towed and/or fined at the owner's expense.
